

Residential Code Training

The Board of Building Standards has contracted with the International Code Council® (ICC®) to conduct training for the 2006 Residential Code of Ohio. The training sessions will begin in May 2006 and all sessions will conclude in late June 2006.

Potential Residential Building Officials, Residential Plans Examiners, Residential Building Inspectors, and Residential Plumbing Inspectors eligible to be certified by the Board of Building Standards should register and attend this training. All attendees will receive 6 hours of continuing education credit that can be used after you become certified by the Board in a residential category. Continuing Education Credit will be granted to all potential Residential Building Officials, Residential Plans Examiners, Residential Building Inspectors, and Residential Plumbing Inspectors
